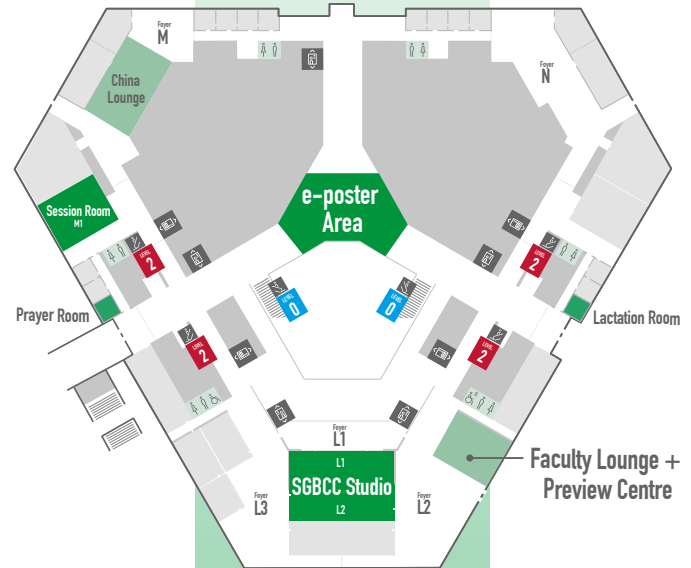

## LEVEL 0

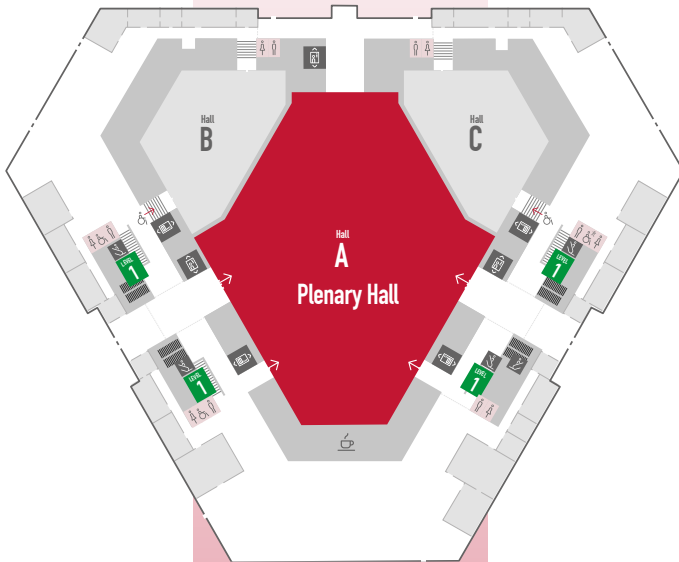
